A number of inherent risks are associated with a domesticated animal activity. A domesticated animal may behave in a manner that results in damages to property or an injury or death to a person. Participant expressly releases Flying Arrow Saddle Club (FASC) and its officers, directors, agents, members and volunteers (collectively referred to as the "Representatives") from any and all claims for personal injury or property damage, even if caused by negligence (if allowed by the laws of this State) by FASC or its Representatives.
